





# Hochpustertal/Alta Pusteria – how to get there Winter 2008/09

# How to get there by car or bus

Driving on the motorway Brennero A22 you take the exit "Bressanone/Val Pusteria". There you continue your journey on the road "SS49-E66" to the Alta Pusteria.

Distance from the exit of the motorway: about 60 km

# Mobilcard - take a holiday from your car

The Mobilcard allows you to visit easily other places and cities, reach your starting point for your excursion or just to enjoy the countryside.

These area-specific cards give you unlimited travel on public transport within a specific part of South Tyrol/Südtirol over a 7-day period. To this end, South Tyrol has been divided into three partially overlapping areas to provide the best network coverage.

## bus and train:

### the Valley of Pustertal/Val Pusteria:

7 days adult: 15,00 EURO 7 days junior: 7,50 EURO

## **South Tyrol:**

7 days adult: 22,00 EURO 7 days junior: 11,00 EURO

3 days adult: 13,00 EURO 3 days junior: 6,50 EURO





# How to get there by train

You reach the village of Franzensfeste/Fortezza in South Tyrol using the international train connections. There you pick the local railway connection to the village of Innichen/San Candido. You will find railway stations in the villages of Niederdorf/Villabassa, Toblach/Dobbiaco and San Candido. The villages Sexten/Sesto and the valley of Pragsertal/Val di Braies are accessible easily by the local bus connections.

- one way 30,00 € and return 45,00 €
- departure from Alta Pusteria:
  - the village of Moos / church at 5.00 pm
  - Sesto / square "Piazza Principale" at 5.05 pm
  - San Candido / square "Piazza del Magistrato" at 5.15 pm
  - Dobbiaco / bus station at 5.20 pm
  - Villabassa / square "Piazza von Kurz" at 5.30 pm
  - Dobbiaco / railway station at 5.35 pm
- arrival at the airport of Treviso at 8.00 pm
- departure from the airport of Treviso at 9.45 pm
